

Terms and Conditions of Purchase Orders - Australia and New Zealand

1. This purchase order constitutes the entire contract between Canon Medical Systems ANZ Pty Limited (Canon Medical) and the supplier and no verbal agreement or other understanding shall in any way modify the contract.
2. If any goods the subject of this order are in any way defective or otherwise not in accordance with description or sample, Canon Medical may at its option reject the same or have the same repaired or repair the same at supplier's expense or if requested by supplier shipped at supplier's expense to such destination as supplier may nominate.
3. This order may be rejected in whole or in part by Canon Medical if the quantity of the goods shipped or date of departure of shipment from port of origin differs significantly from the quantity or date of shipment required by Canon Medical.
4. This order may be cancelled in whole or in part by Canon Medical if, at any time prior to date of shipment from port of origin, there occurs any devaluation of the Australian Dollar or revaluation of Japanese Yen or quota restrictions are imposed on the importation of goods of the kind subject of the order which renders it impractical for Canon Medical to accept delivery of the goods the subject of the order.
5. This order may be rejected in whole or in part by Canon Medical if supplier increases the price of the goods the subject of the order.
6. This order may be cancelled in whole or in part at any time prior to shipment if between the date of the order and the date of shipment new standards are imposed by any competent authority in Australia in respect of goods the subject of the order and such goods will not comply with such standards.
7. Goods must comply with the applicable standards or regulations of the Standards Association of Australia, the Electricity Supply Authorities and the Therapeutic Goods Administration.
